Local Author to Host Book Reading

Vincent James, writing as Jackson Badgenoone (pronounced Badge-No-One), is hosting a book reading at the Eastern Cabarrus Historical Society Museum on Sunday, May 22, at 2:00pm. At the event James will share passages from the soon-to-be-released audio book version of his debut novel, *The Hidden Treasure of Dutch Buffalo Creek*.

Layered in historical fiction, the story is framed in current-day Cabarrus and Rowan counties, but unfolds with a series of flashbacks that lead the central character back to Buffalo Creek. The book contains 10 translucent memoirs that explore the cause and consequences of conflict encountered by a tightly knit clan.

Print versions of the book are available locally at several retail establishments in Concord and Mount Pleasant, and at all four branches of the Cabarrus County library system. Print and eBook versions are also available online at Amazon.com and Barnes & Noble resellers.
